WHAT YOUR STUDENT CAN GAIN:

<u>Empowerment:</u> Have your student run a certain distance, whether in class or at home, and tell them how their miles can make a difference through Operation Smile.

Empathy: When they run that distance, introduce them to Operation Smile's friend in the next country and read their story together or watch a video about them. This is also a good opportunity for them to learn about that country.

<u>Hope:</u> We encourage them to take their involvement to the next level and provide hope for even more patients by fundraising to provide a surgery, hosting a service project, and more.

"Wonder" is a children's novel written by R.J. Palacio. It is about a young boy, Auggie, who was born with mandibulofacial dysostosis.

Being judged and made fun of because of his differences, Auggie tries to not let it get to him – but that all changes when he transitions from homeschooling to in-person middle school. Auggie must navigate the feelings of being surrounded with constant judgement.

Here at Operation Smile, not only do we heal smiles - but we form relationships with our patients and friends born with cleft conditions in our community. We celebrate their "wonder" and meet others who are just like them!

This upcoming school year, we will try to visit as many local schools as possible to inspire the kids to explore what their "wonder" is! We want every child to be seen for who they truly are.
